IT Equipment

Your daughter needs to have her own electronic device which she will use in a variety of ways as part of her education at St Mary's School. We **do not** allow students to use tablets or Chromebooks as their main school device as these use a different operating system to laptops. It does need to be a Windows or Android, and **not** an Apple product or a Smartphone. This is to ensure consistency in the apps used and work produced by your daughter when in lessons or at home. They must not have 4G access on this device. We strongly recommend that you purchase or rent your daughter's device through our partner Easy4U – please see flyers emailed separately to you.

Additional Items

A St Mary's school bag is compulsory for Years 7 – 8 (available from the School Shop). The St Mary's bag is optional for pupils from Year 9 upwards or, alternatively, they should purchase a robust bag, navy/black and large enough to protect school books and files.

Hair bands should be a suitable blue, white or black.

Watches should be small, practical and unobtrusive. Two shaped stud earrings in each ear may be worn. These can be of silver, gold, pearl, 'diamond' or blue shaped stud earrings. No facial or body piercings are permitted nor any jewellery other than a religious symbol necklace or bracelet. Earrings and necklaces must be removed for PE.

ALL ITEMS OF UNIFORM MUST BE CLEARLY NAMED. Woven 'sew-in' name tapes and shoe/property labels are available to order at "The School Shop". Alternatively, 'iron-on' and 'stick-on' labels can be made at the shop 'while-u-wait'.
